Dear Mr. Harris:

Petitioner Simply Wireless, Inc. ("Petitioner") filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the above-referenced case on April 9, 2018. The case was placed on the docket on April 12, 2018. A brief in response to the petition is currently due on May 14, 2018. Respondents T-Mobile US, Inc., f/k/a T-Mobile USA, Inc. and T-Mobile USA Inc. (collectively, "Respondents") seek an extension of 30 days, to and including June 13, 2018, to file their response. Sup. Ct. R. 30.4. Petitioner does not oppose the grant of this 30-day extension.

Respondents' lead appellate counsel in the Fourth Circuit, Joseph M Lipner, was appointed to a state court judgeship and left Irell & Manella LLP on April 11, 2018. Respondents' new lead appellate counsel, Ellisen S. Turner, has commitments in other cases, including depositions outside of the country through May 7, 2018. This extension is necessary and justified for new lead counsel to have time to address the issues raised in the petition.

Accordingly, Respondents respectfully request a 30-day extension, until June 13, 2018, to file its response to Petitioner's petition for writ of certiorari.
