I represent the petitioners in this matter. Our firm timely filed the petition for writ of certiorari in this case on January 23, 2019, having been first retained on January 4, 2019. My objection to the proposed 32-day extension, but consent to an extension to April 15, was based on my own inability to prepare a reply, if warranted, if the brief in opposition is filed May 6. I am scheduled to be out of the office April 24-May 1, and again May 8-May 20. If the brief in opposition is filed April 15, I can file a reply, if warranted, by April 24.
