I write on behalf of my client, Petitioner Charles Don Flores seeking a two-week extension of the grace period for distribution of this case under Rule 15.5.

Respondent (the State of Texas) filed its brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case on December 7, 2020. Therefore, the 14-day extension period would end on December 21, 2020.
