MOTION TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Petitioner Darryl Bryan Barwick moves pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39 to proceed in forma pauperis (IFP) in connection with his application for a stay of execution and petition for a writ of certiorari. Mr. Barwick is an indigent prisoner on Florida's death row with a scheduled execution of May 3, 2023, at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Barwick was previously granted IFP status by Florida's state and federal courts. Counsel for Mr. Barwick, the Capital Habeas Unit of the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida, was appointed to represent Mr.

Barwick by the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, under 18 U.S.C. § 3599, on February 15, 2020.
