Dear Mr. Harris,

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondents American Association of Pro-Life Obstetricians & Gynecologists and the Christian Medical & Dental Associations join in the request with Respondent the State of Texas for an extension of time in which to file a joint response.

The response to the petition for a writ of certiorari is currently due July 22, 2024. Respondents request a thirty-day extension of time to file a joint response with the State of Texas, creating a new filing date of August 21, 2024. This is Respondents' second request for an extension.

The extension is necessary because Respondents' counsel has numerous briefing and argument obligations that will require time and attention.
