Dear Mr. Harris:

The petitions in these two cases were filed on April 16, 2024, and responses are currently due on May 20. On behalf of respondent the People of the State of California, I write to request that the deadline to respond be extended in each case by 30 days, to June 19. The other respondent in these cases, California Labor Commissioner Lilia García-Brower, joins in this request.

This is the first extension respondents have sought. The request is to enable respondents to prepare a brief which best assists the Court. Petitioners have submitted two petitions, each against two respondents, which we seek to address in one unified response on behalf of all respondents. In addition, we have already been notified by two amici that they intend to file amicus briefs in support of the petitions; those briefs will be due on the date currently set for our own response.

Accordingly, we respectfully request that the date in which to respond to the petitions in these cases be extended to June 19.
