Dear Mr. Harris:

I represent the respondent, Anne Arundel County, Maryland, in the above-captioned case. On June 27, 2024, the Court requested that respondent file a response to the certiorari petition, with a deadline of July 29, 2024. I respectfully request that the time to file a response be extended by 28 days, to and including August 26, 2024.

The extension is warranted because the attorneys responsible for the brief have multiple deadlines in several other matters that will require their attention over the coming weeks, including drafting the petitioners' brief in *NVIDIA Corp., et al. v. E. Ohman J:or Fonder AB, et al.*, No. 23-970 (U.S.), currently due on August 1; drafting the petitioner's brief in *Duffey v. United States*, No. 23-1150 (U.S.), currently due on August 16; and drafting a supplemental brief in the Second Circuit on remand from this Court in *National Rifle Association v. Vullo*, No. 21-636 (2d Cir.), due July 29. Given these commitments and others, an extension of time is warranted to permit counsel to prepare a response that fully responds to the arguments raised in the petition for certiorari.
