Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time to File Brief in Opposition

Dear Clerk of the Court:

In the above-referenced case, the Petition for Writ of Certiorari was filed on June 28, 2024, and placed on the Court's docket on July 2, 2024. Pursuant to Rule 15.3, the due date for Respondent's brief in opposition is Thursday, August 1, 2024. Respondent intends to timely file its brief in opposition pursuant to Rules 15.1 and 15.2.

Over the past several days, Respondent has received notices from counsel for several *amici curiae* that they intend to file *amicus curiae* briefs in support of the Petitioner. Respondent acknowledged receipt of said notices pursuant to Rule 37.2. Respondent therefore anticipates that the briefs of *amici curiae* will be timely filed by August 1, 2024, pursuant to Rule 37.2.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondent hereby moves for an extension of time to the time period in Rule 15.3 to respond to the petition in this case. This extension of time is sought by Respondent to enable Respondent to address in its opposition the arguments of *amici curiae* urged in support of the petition. Respondent requests an extension of time of twenty-nine (29) days to file its brief in opposition to and including August 30, 2024.

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This motion is not sought to prejudice any party, and Respondent does not believe that any party will be prejudiced by this extension of time. This motion is not sought to cause unnecessary delay in these proceedings, but is sought in the interest of justice so that Respondent may address and respond to all arguments presented by Petitioner and presented in support of Petitioner by *amici curiae*. By copy of this letter, counsel for Petitioner are being notified of this motion and request for extension of time.
