Dear Honorable Harris:

I am counsel for the respondent in this case. Petitioner filed their petition for a writ of certiorari on June 28, 2024. According to the online docket and pursuant to Rule 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, a response is currently due on August 1, 2024. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondent respectfully requests that the time for filing a response be extended by 30 days, to and including September 3, 2024.

This is respondent's first request for an extension of time to file a response. Good cause exists for the requested extension. The additional time sought in this request is because of the press of other client business leading up to and immediately following the current deadline including multiple court hearings and counsel's pre-scheduled travel obligations. Additional time is also needed, if a brief in opposition is authorized, to permit its preparation and printing. An extension of time would better enable preparation of a response that would be most helpful to the Court.
