Dear Mr. Harris:

The Court docketed the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case on February 12, 2024. Respondents waived response on March 13, 2024. On March 25, 2024, the Court called for a response, which is currently due April 24, 2024.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 15.3 and 30.4, Respondents respectfully request a 27-day, unopposed extension to May 21, 2024, to file their brief in opposition. Skadden was first retained to represent certain Respondents before this Court, alongside Charles S. Fax and other co-counsel, who represent all Respondents and join this extension request on behalf of all Respondents. The extension is necessary given the heavy press of other business.
