I am counsel of record for the petitioner in this case. On July 18, the Court extended the time to file the petitioner's brief on the merits to and including September 9, 2024, and the time to file respondent's brief on the merits to and including October 21, 2024.

Having conferred with counsel for the respondent, I write to respectfully request that the court further extend these deadlines by seven days each, as follows:

Brief for the petitioner (and joint appendix, if any): September 16, 2024 Brief for the respondent: October 28, 2024

This schedule would permit this case to be heard during the Court's December sitting. As required by Rule 25.3, the petitioner will ensure that her reply brief is actually received by the Clerk no later than 10 days before the date of oral argument. Counsel for the respondent does not oppose this request.

I am also counsel of record for the respondent in No. 23-970, *NVIDIA Corp.*, *et al. v. E. Ohman J:or Fonder AB*, *et al.*, which is set for oral argument on Wednesday, November 13. Good cause exists for the requested extensions because they would enable counsel to manage a press of other business in this Court and others, including the briefing and oral argument in No. 23-970, and to ensure adequate time for argument preparation in both cases.
