MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME

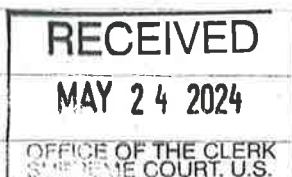
