Request for extensions of time

Dear Mr. Harris:

I write on behalf of the respondent to request extensions of time in which to oppose the petition for certiorari and the stay application in the above-captioned matter. The current deadline for the opposition to the petition for certiorari is September 13, 2024, and the current deadline for the opposition to the stay application is September 16, 2024. Respondent respectfully seeks a 30-day extension of time, up to and including October 15, 2024, to oppose both the petition and the stay application.¹ I seek this extension for two reasons. First, upcoming oral arguments and briefing deadlines in other matters will make it very difficult for me and for the other attorneys on this matter to meet the current deadlines. Second, the requested extension would provide respondent with an opportunity to respond as appropriate to the amicus briefs that we have been told will be filed in support of the petition.

Counsel for petitioners have informed my colleagues that they consent to this extension request.

¹ Thirty days from the current deadline for the opposition to the petition is October 13, which is a Sunday. The first business day after that Sunday is October 15, because October 14 is a federal holiday.
