**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DISPENSE
WITH PREPARATION OF A JOINT APPENDIX**

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 26.8, Petitioner in the above-captioned matter respectfully moves for leave to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix in this case. Respondent and the Court-appointed *Amicus Curiae* agree that a joint appendix is not necessary.

This case presents a purely legal question: Whether a litigant who files a notice of appeal after the ordinary appeal period expires must file a second, duplicative notice after the appeal period is reopened.
