Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Intervenor Attorney General Keith Ellison requests a 14-day extension of time to file a response to the petition for a writ of certiorari in this matter. A response is currently due August 16, 2024. A 14-day extension would make a response due August 30, 2024.

Attorney General Ellison submits that good cause exists for the extension. This is intervenor's first request for an extension of time to file a response, and the request is relatively short. Good cause exists for the requested extension. Apart from this case, I represent the State of Minnesota and its agencies in several other matters and review appellate work product for several additional cases; those responsibilities require substantial amounts time in the coming weeks. I also have a long-planned vacation in the interim. An extension of time would better enable preparation of a response that would be most helpful to the Court.
