ORDER APPOINTING COUNSEL  
UNDER ARTICLE 11.071, SEC. 2, V.A.C.C.P.

Applicant was convicted of the offense of capital murder in Cause No. 723847 styled The State of Texas v. Garcia Glen White, in the 180th District Court of Harris County. Punishment was assessed at death. The cause is currently on direct appeal in our Cause No. 72,580.

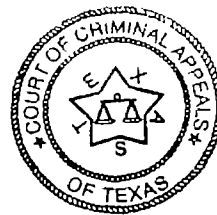
