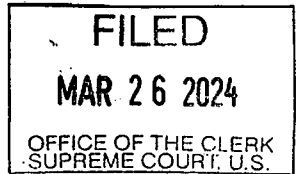

Therefore, after all montly payments in order to survive, the total amount of money I have left after every month is just over \$142.00. Accordingly, due to over-taxation and inflation I cannot afford the cost and fees associated with this case.
