
The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on January 27, 2025, and placed on the docket on January 29, 2025. Global Media Group LLC's ("GlobalMed") response is due on February 28, 2025.

We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the rules of this Court, an extension of time to and including March 31, 2025, within which to file GlobalMed's response.

This extension is requested to complete the preparation of GlobalMed's response, which has been delayed by the heavy caseload of the attorneys handling this matter, and by strategic considerations as to whether the petition merits the filing of a separate brief in opposition from GlobalMed.
