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APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI

To: Associate Justice Amy Coney Barrett, Circuit Justice for the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit:

Under this Court's Rules 13.5 and 22, Applicant Mr. Anthony Patterson ("Applicant") respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days to file a petition for a writ of certiorari. The forthcoming petition will seek review of the decision of the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals in *Baz v. Patterson*, No. 23-3407 (7th Cir., 2024), a copy of which is attached to this application along with the denial of rehearing in the same matter. In support of this application, Applicant states the following:

- 1. The Seventh Circuit issued its opinion on April 30, 2024. The Applicant thereafter sought panel and *en banc* rehearing, which was denied on June 6, 2024.
- 2. Without an extension, pursuant to Rule 13.3, the petition for a writ of certiorari will be due on September 4, 2024. With the requested extension of thirty (30) days, the petition would be due on October 4, 2024. Consistent with Rule 13.5, the instant application is filed more than ten (10) days before the petition for certiorari is currently due. This Court's jurisdiction will be based on 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1).
- 3. There is good cause for this extension request. The undersigned counsel, who act *pro bono* for the Applicant, have multiple conflicting professional and

personal engagements between now and September 4, 2024, a short extension is sought and no further extension is anticipated to be required.

4. This application should be granted, and the deadline for Applicants to file their petition for a writ of certiorari should be extended to October 4, 2024.
