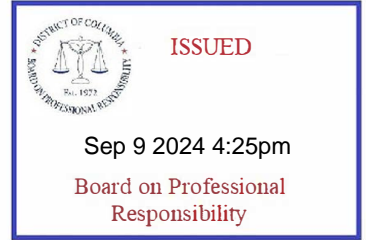

ORDER

Upon consideration of Respondent’s Unopposed Motion to Change the Briefing Schedule and Statement Regarding Oral Argument Date, and it appearing that Disciplinary Counsel consents to the relief sought therein, the Board’s September 5, 2024 Order shall be amended solely as delineated herein. It is hereby

ORDERED that Disciplinary Counsel’s opening brief shall be filed no later than October 7, 2024; and it is further

ORDERED that Respondent’s responsive brief shall be filed no later than October 28, 2024; and it is further

ORDERED that on or before November 8, 2024, Disciplinary Counsel shall file its reply brief; and it is further

ORDERED that on or before November 19, 2024, Respondent may file a surreply brief; and it is further

ORDERED that the oral argument in this matter will be held at 2:00 p.m. on December 19, 2024 in Courtroom II of the District of Columbia

Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W. Per Administrative Order 2023-1, any request for the argument to be held via Zoom must be made in Respondent's brief to the Board. Absent exigent circumstances, any motion for a continuance of the oral argument date must be filed no later than 14 days before the argument date and must set forth the opposing party's position on the motion. If the parties determine that oral argument is not necessary, they may waive oral argument in a joint filing with the Board.
