MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME

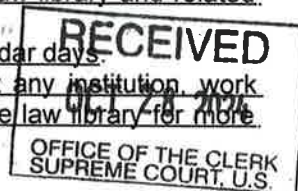
Comes now, the Petitioner, Edvin Santiagomazariegos, pursuant to *United States Supreme Court Rule 30* (2) and hereby moves this Honorable Court to grant a sixty (60) day enlargement of time in which to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari. The following is offered in support thereof:

1. Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Certiorari is due on or before November 5, 2024.

2. Petitioner relies, extensively, on an inmate law clerk for assistance in research and preparation of his legal documents and, under normal circumstances, access to the law library and inmate law clerks is restricted to one-half (½) day per week unless there is a deadline imposed by law, court rule, or court order and then priority access is granted for two and one-half (2 ½) days per week beginning 20, 1 calendar, days before the end of the deadline. Furthermore due to hurricanes Helene and Milton the law

1. Priority access shall be granted if the maximum time limit is 20 or fewer calendar days.
2. Law library supervisors shall not excuse an inmate in open population at any institution, work camp, road prison, or forestry camp from a work or program assignment to use the law library for more than one-half of the inmate's workweek.



library was open, for priority access ² only, on September 25th 2024 and October 8th 2024 and was closed on September 24th26th, and 27th, 2024 and October 7th,9th,10th, and 11th 2024 respectively thus, Petitioner needs more time to adequately research, prepare, and obtain copies of, his Petition for Writ of Certiorari .

3. Due to his incarceration Petitioner is unable to contact the Respondent therefore it is unknown whether there is any objection to this enlargement of time

4. This request for an enlargement of time is made in good faith and not for the purposes of undue delay and Respondent will not be prejudiced by this enlargement.

Wherefore, based upon the foregoing, Petitioner prays this Honorable Court will grant a sixty (60) day enlargement of time so Petitioner may adequately research, prepare, and obtain copies of, his Petition for Writ of Certiorari .
