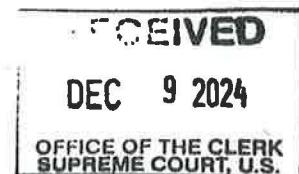

APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

To the Honorable Elena Kagan, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States

After losing her case at the US District Court, petitioner appealed to the Court of Appeals at the Ninth Circuit that she lost. A panel rehearing or a rehearing en banc, was denied on September 20th, 2024. (Attached here as Exhibit A).

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 13.5, 22, and 30, Petitioner Prabhjot K. Kang respectfully applies to this Court for an order extending the time to file her petition for a writ of certiorari from December 20th, 2024, until February 18th, 2025, a period of sixty (60) days.

JURISDICTION

The jurisdiction of this court will be invoked under 28 U.S.C §1254(1) and the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari will expire without an extension on December 20th, 2024. This application is timely because it has been filed more than ten days prior to the date on which the time to file the petition will expire.

REASONS JUSTIFYING AN EXTENSION OF TIME

- (1) I am handling my case Pro Se.
- (2) I am working in retail at a department store. The fourth quarter is the busiest time of the year especially the month of December and this year is no exception. I cannot get time off during this busiest shopping season of the year.
- (3) In order to write an effective petition, I need more time to research. Currently, I do not have enough time to research and complete my petition. A one-time extension of 60 days will give me the opportunity to prepare an effective petition.

Therefore, in the interest of justice and for good cause shown, petitioner Prabhjot K. Kang respectfully requests that this Court extend the current December 20th, 2024, deadline until February 18th, 2025.
