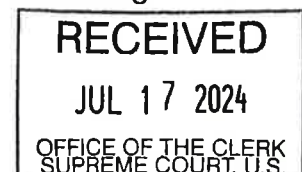
RE : Application to extend the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari

Dear Hon. Sotomayor,

I, as the petitioner in this matter, am proceeding Pro Se. I intend to submit a petition for a writ of certiorari. Pursuant to Rule 13 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States and in accordance with the online docket, the petition will be deemed timely if filed with the Clerk of this Court within 90 days following the entry of judgment, which is scheduled for July 23, 2024.

I am requesting an extension of time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari. There is good cause for this requested extension. Previously, I was represented by counsel but became unable to afford legal expenses, so I decided to proceed Pro Se. As a result, I require more time to understand the relevant legal issues and rules involved. Additionally, I have surgery scheduled for next month.
