Application for Extension of 'Time to File a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari

Pursuant to Supreme Court rule 13, Petitioner, Dessie Andrews, respectfully requests an extension of 60 days to file a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in this cause.

This extension is sought due to the difficulty and the seriousness inherent in the filing and the research required in preparing the writ, and the fact that the correspondence between the Court and myself, has taken almost a month each time.

The original deadline for filing the Petition was December 24, 2024.

On December 5, 2024, I mailed a Request for Extension of Time for 60 days but failed to include the Judgment of the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals.

I didn't receive the delinquency notice until the 27th of December 2024.

On December 28, 2025, I mailed a second request, this time enclosing the judgment.

I received the answer to this request on January 28 2025, which informed me that my request had been granted for 30 days and ended on January 24, 2025. I called Court Clerk for clarification and was told to submit this application for extension for the original request for 60 days, which would make my petition due on February 23, 2025.

I am respectfully requesting that the Court grant an extension of the 60 days for filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari. This extension is necessary to ensure complete and thorough preparation of the Petition, promoting the administration of justice.
