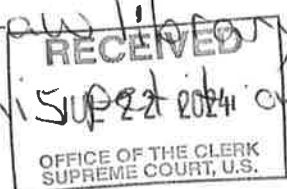
Petition For Certiorary For the Denial of Ricky

I. ARGUMENT

Abner is currently in lockdown and does not
have access to his legal work or the Law Library
to be able to draft, research or submit his petition on

for certiorari to the Supreme Court of the United States.

Abner has requested BOP staff to provide him his legal work from his property at least 15 times, but BOP staff have refused his requests, stating that Abner can have his legal work when he is released from lockdown.

This request for an extension of time is made in good faith. Without this request, Abner will be prejudiced by not being able to file his Petition for Certiorari on time.

II. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE Petitioner Ricky Abner respectfully requests this Honorable Court to grant this motion giving Abner a 60 day extension of time to file his Petition for Certiorari, or grant any other relief the Court deems appropriate.

Persuant to the prison "mailbox" rule this motion was deemed filed on Friday June 21, 2024, when it was provided to BOP staff for forwarding to the U.S. Postal Service with prepaid postage for forwarding to the United States Supreme Court.
