**MOTION FOR EXTENTION OF TIME**



COMES NOW, the Petitioner-appellant and respectfully moves this court of an extension of time.

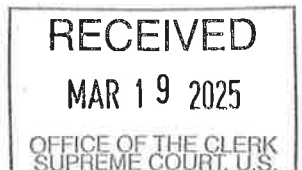
