#### MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI



Pursuant to Supreme Court **Rule 13.5** and **Rule 30.2**, Petitioner, Thomas I. Miles, acting pro se, respectfully moves for an extension of time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the judgment of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court entered on December 23, 2024<sup>1</sup>, Docket No. 316 MAL 2024, with a Docket Number of underlying criminal case of, CR-2885-18.

- 1. Original Deadline: The 90-day period for filing the petition expires on March 23, 2025.
- Requested Extension: Petitioner seeks an extension of 60 days, making the new deadline May 22,
   2025.
- 3. Reason for Extension:
  - a) Petitioner became pro se on January 10, 2024, four days before his incarceration of eight weeks<sup>2</sup>. Given the complexity of this eight-year-old case, Petitioner requests additional

time to compile and review the voluminous trial record, and research the filing of this

appeal.

b) The fact that Petitioner was not notified from his appellate attorney that the PA Supreme

Court had denied his appeal until 10 days later, and failed to fully explain his options with

the U.S. Supreme Court, further delayed Petitioners completion of his appeal.

c) Being pro se, Petitioners incarceration severely hindered and delayed his ability to prepare

his appeal, due to the lack of materials and the access to transcripts and other records

needed to prepare his appeal while incarcerated. Without counsel, Petitioner's requests for

transcripts and filings to the Court were not completed during his eight-week incarceration.

4. Consultation with Opposing Counsel: Petitioner has contacted Respondent's Counsel, to ask for

consent to this request, to date petitioner has not received a response, but Petitioner respectfully

submits that good cause exists for granting the extension.
